

COMPANY HEALTH & SAFETY POLICY STATEMENT

Evans Maintenance, recognises and accepts its responsibility as an employer for providing a safe and healthy workplace and working environment for all its Employees.

Evans Maintenance will take all steps within its power to meet this responsibility, paying particular attention to the provision and maintenance of:

- Equipment and systems of work that is safe.
- Safe arrangements for the use, handling, storage and transport of articles and substances
- Sufficient information, instruction, training and supervision to enable all Employees to avoid hazards and contribute positively to their own Safety at work.
- A safe place of work, and safe access to it.
- A healthy working environment.
- Adequate first-aid and welfare facilities.
- Consultation on all matters directly affecting individual's work
- Safe systems, which will afford protection to visitors and members of the public from Evans Maintenance 's operations

Evans Maintenance regards Health and Safety as a prime responsibility and will appoint competent persons with specific responsibilities.

Evans Maintenance will, in line with Health and Safety requirements, carry out risk assessments on all Evans Maintenance's operations.

Evans Maintenance will have documented safe systems of work relevant to the operations being undertaken.

Evans Maintenance will have Planned Preventative Maintenance Schedules on portable plant equipment.

Without detracting from the primary responsibility of supervision for ensuring safe conditions of work, Evans Maintenance will provide competent technical advice on Health and Safety matters where this is necessary to assist employees with their intended tasks.

Competent H&S advisors have been appointed to provide health and safety assistance.

No Health & Safety Policy is likely to be successful unless it actively involves the Employees themselves. Evans Maintenance will therefore co-operate fully in the appointment of Safety Representatives who will be provided with appropriate facilities and training necessary to carry out this task.

However, Evans Maintenance reminds its Employees of their own duties under Section 7 & 8 of the Health and Safety at Work etc. Act 1974, to take care for their own Safety and that of other workers and anyone else affected by their action or inaction, to co-operate with Evans Maintenance so as to enable it to carry out its own responsibilities successfully and not to interfere with, or misuse anything provided for their health and Safety.

A copy of this statement will be issued to all areas of the company. It will be reviewed, added to, or modified from time to time and may be supplemented in appropriate cases by further statements relating to the work of particular activities within Evans Maintenance.
